Pickleball is a racquet sport that combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis. Two or four players use solid paddles made of wood or composite materials to hit a perforated polymer ball, similar to a wiffle ball, over a net. The sport shares features of other racquet sports, the dimensions and layout of a badminton court, and a net and rules similar to tennis, with a few modifications. You do not have to know how to play in order to participate. You will be taught the game!

FOR MATURE TEENS AND ADULTS

Games are scheduled for M-W-F. Play will begin at 10 am and end at approximately 1 pm. Participants are responsible for set-up and take-down of equipment. Two courts will be available for single or doubles play. Daily sign-in will determine the schedule of players/teams. This activity is open to the public for free play.
